Per Arkansas state law and Bentonville district policy, please note:

- A SIGNED permission slip must be on file BEFORE checking out a box of chocolate.
- The student's Charms account will be charged \$60 when a box is checked out.
- Money must be turned in before another box of chocolate is checked out.
- Once checked out a box of chocolate, even unopened, may not be returned.
- Please no door-to-door selling your child's safety is important.
- Selling of chocolate bars **CANNOT** happen during school hours or in the school building. Students may sell chocolate bars outside the building starting at 2:30pm. Failure to comply could result in inability to participate and full payment.

Profits of \$25.00 per box sold will be returned to your student's Charms account to help reduce their share of band program costs when the full \$60.00 is received. Any shortage will be reflected in the amount of profit posted. Checks or cash is accepted and can be retuned to the safe located in the band director office. Warm temperatures will melt chocolate. DO NOT leave in car or heat.
