



2021-2022 Financial Letter

Bentonville West Band

Thank you for your commitment to the Bentonville West Band and for joining the **Midnight Regiment**. Our goal is for students to learn many life skills that will carry with them for the rest of their lives. We have an exciting show developed for the upcoming season which involve several expenses required to enable our program and support our students. The detail below will provide an overview of the costs involved and options for payment as part of your financial obligation required for membership in the Bentonville West Midnight Regiment.

Fair Share Fee - Commitment and Coverage

This season the Midnight Regiment will traveling to contests in Owasso, OK, Bentonville, AR, Region Assessment (local), State Marching Contest in Little Rock and the Bands of America Super Regional in St. Louis, MO. **The all-inclusive fair share cost per student is \$530 for Winds, Percussion and Color Guard (includes guard uniform).** Students will incur some additional costs for uniform accessories and instrument rental. Students will not be asked for additional payment related to travel or meals for band sanctioned events throughout the season.

Program expenses covered as part of this fee include:

- Professional show design (music, drill, choreography, props)
- Transportation (all football games and contests)
- Overnight lodging (BOA Super Regional in St Louis, MO)
- Meals (all football games, contests and extended rehearsals)
- Contest registration fees and membership dues
- 1st set of gloves for winds/percussion, member uniform shirt

Additional non-covered expenses would include:

- Marching band shoes
- Gloves
- Reeds
- Black socks
- Compression shirt and shorts
- Color Guard dance shoes, makeup, gloves, rifle

Fair Share Fee - Payment Options

Each parent's commitment to the full and timely payment of their fees is critical to our ability to honor and maintain the financial obligations necessary to operate the program. A fee schedule is provided below if you wish to pay in installments. The Wolverine Band Boosters will offer many fundraising opportunities over the season such as chocolate sales or AMP concert volunteering to help cover all fees and are available to help provide financial assistance to those who qualify.
